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Objective


To increase the comfort of our daily life, for example, we will not have to be careful when our skirt will open.




Guys in short skirts....

Why do we still make girls wear skirts and dresses as school uniform?

Study conducted in one Australian primary school in 2012 found that girls did significantly less exercise over a two-week period when wearing a school dress than they did when wearing shorts.



Research by the Australian Bureau of Statistics shows that young women do significantly less physical activity than young men.

Reasons given for this include the fear of being judged or ridiculed, and the tension between wanting to appear feminine and attractive, and the sweaty, muscular image attached to active girls.



It can be argued that making girls wear skirts and dresses plays directly into this tension and their fears. In an attempt to support girls exercising more, the Australian government launched a campaign in February 2016 called "Girls Make Your Move".

The focus on girls is important, as regular physical activity and exercise are associated with improved school performance, a greater sense of personal responsibility and group cooperation, and reduced drug and alcohol consumption.

While expensive education and awareness campaigns may encourage more girls to engage in sport, a simple change to what they are required to wear to school could have a far greater impact.



Ireland primary school

St Brigid's National School 'is the name of the school that wants to modify the use of the school uniform. To help students in their schools who still have not made a decision or who still have questions about their gender, feel comfortable wearing uniforms for school. The next group will not wear a skirt or a school uniform in Thailand.



One of the countries / territories that has seen significant advances in gender equality is Taiwan, where the school uniform issue, the Taiwan government, has lifted a policy that requires students to wear gender-specific school uniforms to promote gender-specific student uniforms. This came after male students and teachers in Banqiao Senior High School began wearing each other in May 2019 to break up the myths about gender.



Before that, in 2011, a male student from Impington Village College said they disagreed with the school not allowing students to wear shorts in the summer, and then put-on protest skirts. At the same time, the Welsh government announced that school uniforms should not be used to determine how male and female students must dress. Children should make their own decisions. Which many views it as something that is "reasonable"




Can you introduce yourself and share a bit about your story?

I'm Jenny-Anne Bishop, an older married trans woman (69), living with my trans partner Ellen in Rhyl, North Wales. I've been out as a trans* person for over 45 years, but family and work pressure restrained me from full time transitioning until about 9 years ago.


I was born on the outskirts of West London and grew up in Surrey and Kent, knowing from about 4 years old that my sense of who I was did not match my physical body. I first saw a psychiatrist about "gender non-conforming behavior" at six years old in 1952. All through my childhood and early adult life I dressed in secret as my true self, having learnt it was greatly discouraged by my parents, school and my church. While exploring gender diversity and possible transitioning at University, I was strongly encouraged to get married and have a family as a "cure" to my "deviant" behavior.

While **Jenny-Anne Bishop** of Unique Transgender Network said she is very pleased with the change, UK-based Stevensons school uniform has decided not to sell school uniforms for boys or girls. But they will also promote gender neutral school uniforms, not gender neutral.



In 1998, **David Brunsma and Kerry A.** Rockquemore published a study entitled Effects of Student Uniforms on Attendance, Behavior Problems, Substance Use, and Academic Achievement, in The Journal of Educational Research Issue 92, Volume 1, Pages 53-62. The effects of school uniforms on attendance, based on the National Educational Longitudinal Study (NELS) survey, did not find that school uniforms had any effect on attendance. Behavior problem the use of drugs and their educational achievement. This is a study from data surveyed from the entire United States.

Female student questionnaire results



From the questionnaire, the results were as follows: People who are satisfied to wear a skirt or not. Skirts are not comfortable to wear, but still have a preference for school uniforms in the current style. Most of the people have accidents from wearing skirts, and lastly, most people agree with Thai student skirt projects that want to add pants Came in a female uniform.
